Focus Areas

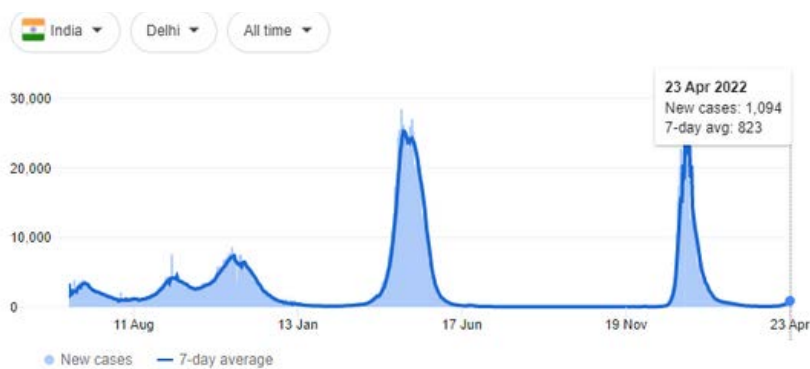

International Women's Day: Women's Day is celebrated every year on March 8. At ROOP, The day was full of informative sessions. Trainers from SMART NGO took session on women rights for 70 female contractual workers. We were also privileged to have our Board Member, Ms. Anandi Iyer who took session for female staff across locations.

Roop VK Jain Foundation also organized Mammography tests for schools teachers and community members. This camp was sponsored by Rotary Club, Gurugram. In total, 17 women tested for mammogram.

Women Empowerment

Badhte Kadam: Empowerment of Women and Girls to recover from post pandemic crisis: In the FY 2021-22, Roop VK Jain Foundation has partnered with CEQUIN to implement project on Women Empowerment. During the reporting period, 9 mohalla pathshala, 6 session on functional literacy and 6 Nari ki choupal session were conducted covering more than 200 women from marginalized community.



Hinsa ko "No": In the FY 2021-22, the foundation has partnered with "Seeking Modern Applications for Real Transformation" to broadcast and narrowcast 18 episodes of Radio programs on domestic violence. These episodes covered different aspects on domestic violence. In total 15 cases that have come up during the narrocasting were further mediated by Radio Mewat. IF the issue persists, the women will be further supported in filing cases in the "One Stop Centre" at Nuh Administration. In total 445 women were covered.



Case of Change

Zaheera is about 30 years old. She got married 11 years ago with Junaid, a resident of Sakras. The victim has an eight-year-old son. Zaheera's husband divorced some years ago. The reason for giving divorce was given that Zaheera is not beautiful to look at. She has been living in her maternal home in Mahrola for many years now. Zaheera has not taken any legal action against him till date. When we asked them why did you not take legal action, the victim told that they do not have enough money to fight. Radio Mewat suggested that the victim can file case against Junaid under the law of triple talaq, in which the police will definitely take action against him. Case will not cost her any money. With the help of DLSA she will be given a free lawyer and if she wants, can also take the help of Radio Mewat in getting the case resolved. She was motivated to not hide a crime like triple talaq and that she should come up with her voice raised.

Education

Computer Lab at Roz Ka Meo Govt. Middle School: Roop VK Jain Foundation had setup Computer lab in Roz Ka Meo Govt. Middle School. Due to the degraded condition of the school building, the lab is shifted to new building. Currently 17 computer systems are installed with a LED screen. Informative posters are also displayed on the walls of lab. More than 300 students will be benefitted with the computer lab



Roop-Anganwadi support program: RVKJF partnered with SRF Foundation to implement project on physical and academic transformation of 2 Anganwadi centres in Roz Ka Meo village. The pandemic has affected the functioning of anganwadi centres as well and children were unable to get the benefits of it. Hence in the first phase, the physical transformation for anganwadi project is implemented successfully.

Health

Health Checkup Camp: Roop VK Jain Foundation organized health checkup camp in Partnership with ESI dispensary at Dharuhera. In total for 220 community members were tested for different illness. The medicines were dispensed free of cost.
